Arkansas Virtual Academy Dyslexia Program 2024-2025

During the 2023-2024 school year, Arkansas Virtual Academy used the evidenced-based, International Dyslexia Association Accredited, and IMSLEC Accredited Program Brainspring. Brainspring Phonics First was used with students in grades K-4, and Brainspring Structures was used with students in grades 5-12. Dyslexia Interventions were administered with fidelity in small group classes to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. UFLI Curriculum was also implemented to cover gaps in Phonics First and Structures.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention 2024-2025

During the 2024-2025 school year, **243** students attending Arkansas Virtual Academy received Dyslexia intervention services from a trained Dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia 2024-2025

During the 2024-2025 school year, **735** students attending Arkansas Virtual Academy in grades K-3rd were screened for Dyslexia using the Atlas K-3 Initial Screener. During the 2024-2025 school year, **1,500 testlets were administered in the Atlas portal to students in grades K-5.**

During the 2024-2025 school year, **76** students attending Arkansas Virtual Academy in grades K-12th were screened for Dyslexia using a **Level 1 Screener.**

During the 2024-2025 school year, **41** students attending Arkansas Virtual Academy in grades K-12th were screened for Dyslexia using a **Level 2 Screener.**

During the 2024-2025 school year, **36** students in grades K-12th were **identified** as exhibiting the characteristics of Dyslexia.
